### Walkthrough Energy Assessments

- ✓ **No-cost energy assessments** for K-12 schools and small commercial buildings that are <50,000 sqft in the Greater Lansing Area
- ✓ Energy assessment components:
  - Preliminary energy assessment using utility bills
  - Few hour site visit
  - Focus on low- and no-cost recommendations, with identification of capital projects
  - Rough cost and energy savings estimations
  - Report containing findings
